We are currently offering <u>2 Week Undergraduate Programs</u> based in <u>Belize</u> and the <u>Dominican Republic</u> and <u>1 Week graduate programs</u>. We also offer specialty AAC programs and more.

Therapy Abroad students and staff provide essential services such as speech & language screenings, evaluations and intervention. Students and staff will also take part in a communications learning camp for children with special needs designed around skill based stations (learning centers) speaking/listening/learning/sensory/fine & gross motor skills. Each day students will have group discussion as well as one on one time with SLPs and other professionals. Students will also take part in home-based field visits as part of a small interdisciplinary team consisting of SLPs, social workers and medical doctors. Your team will work with children and parents focusing on speech & language, feeding, swallowing disorders, behavior modification and special education. You will learn, observe, share ideas, and work on developing critical observation skills in clinical, school and a home environments.

Time will also be set aside to learn new concepts, practice skills and learn about local culture and history. Students will gain hands-on and observational experience working in a variety of settings, leadership experience as well as insight and discussion on applying to graduate schools and/or post graduate career opportunities as an SLP.
