Voluntary COVID-19 Testing



COVID-19 Monitoring and Assessment Program (MAP) has expanded COVID-19 testing to include key employee and student groups. Testing is voluntary, not mandatory.

Eligible employees — those whose work requires them to be on campus and is key to keeping the university open.

Do not participate if you:

- Tested or diagnosed as positive for COVID-19 in the past 90 days.
- Are currently isolating or quarantining due to contact with a known positive case.
- Are feeling sick or experiencing COVID-19 symptoms.

There is no cost for testing. Employees may participate while on-shift during work time. However, employees who do not normally work during the time the testing is provided may still participate but will need to do so on their own time.

- The testing process should only take 15-30 minutes to complete from arrival to departure.
- The testing procedure involves a self-collected nasal swab.
- Participants will be notified of their test results within four days. If you test positive, you
 will receive a phone call with your results. You will be able to choose to receive your
 results via secure email or mailed by US Postal Service in the event COVID-19 is not
 detected in your sample.
