The Division of Graduate Studies offers a service for students to receive feedback on resumes, CVs, & cover letters for academic-adjacent or non-academic job/internship applications. This service will be available throughout the summer.

Curricular Practical Training (CPT)

CPT enables F1 students to engage in off-campus employment. You need to register for credit, but UO waives your tuition during your summer CPT.

Types of CPT

- 1. Mandatory for their degree
 - when your degree program requires internship or field work experience
- 2. Integral to their thesis, final project, or dissertation when internship is integral to completion of master's thesis/final project/dissertation
- 3. Elective internship

when your department or career enter offers elective internship credit for an internship, employment, practicum, or fieldwork experience related to your field

Note

- The relationship between your employment and your major/field is reviewed and authorized by ISSS, not the Department of Homeland Security.
- You are allowed to work full time in summer under CPT.

Application Process for CPT

- 1 Login to iconnect.uoregon.edu and submit the CPT-I20 Request e-form under the F-1 Practical Training menu
- 2 Upload a copy of an internship or job offer.
- 3 Provide the email address of an academic or faculty advisor who can verify the type of CPT request
- 4 Students cannot begin working until the CPT employment start date is recorded in SEVIS
- 5 ISSS advisor will print out an updated I-20 reflecting the CPT authorization
- 6 Student will present the CPT I-20 to the employer, along with a valid passport and I-94 arrival record, for I-9 verification
- 7 Summer only: Register for no-tuition GRST 604 by sending your CPT approval email from ISSS to graduatestudies@uoregon.edu.
