Where: the HEDCO Education Building.

When: Spring term—tutoring begins week 3.

Tutoring: Tutors will provide individual or small group reading and/or math instruction to struggling learners in kindergarten, 1st, or 2nd grade, 2 days per week (Monday - Thursday).



Tutoring Options:

- Tutor for credit (1 credit = 1 hour twice per week on Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday; 2 credits = 2 hours twice per week on Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday, OR 1 hour per day Monday-Thursday)
- Complete 30-40 hours of field study or practicum for a course
- Volunteer to tutor in reading and/or math

Training: Tutors participate in 6 hours of initial training prior to the start of tutoring, during the first two weeks of the term.
