## **Over the Top Award for Graduate Students in CPHS**

**Goal**: The goal of this research award is to increase the peer-reviewed publications of graduate students in CPHS.

**Summary**: Graduate students across our master's and doctoral programs in CPHS engage in a range of research projects. The projects often require additional support to be competitive for peer-reviewed journal publication. The support may include services such as statistical consultation, data analyses, and editorial support. This award is intended to provide financial compensation to students who engage these supports and publish their article in a peer-reviewed journal.

**Eligibility**: Any graduate student in CPHS who is either a matriculated student or within 3 months of graduation (one quarter).

**Amount of Award**: Costs up to \$2000.00 will be reimbursed to support data analyses, statistical consultation, and/or writing.

**Application**: Applications will be accepted at any time for this award and should be submitted to the Department Head. Applications should include a one-page written summary of the article, amount requested, faculty advisor name and signature (can be electronic) and targeted journal. You may submit the application before the article is accepted for publication, but the award will not be made until appropriate documentation is provided.

**Reimbursment**: This award is set-up to reimburse costs that are involved in submitting a high-quality research article. In order to receive the award, you will need the following items: 1) receipts from the support you paid for up to \$2000.00; and 2) documentation confirming that your article is "in press." Awards will be processed after these documents have been submitted.
